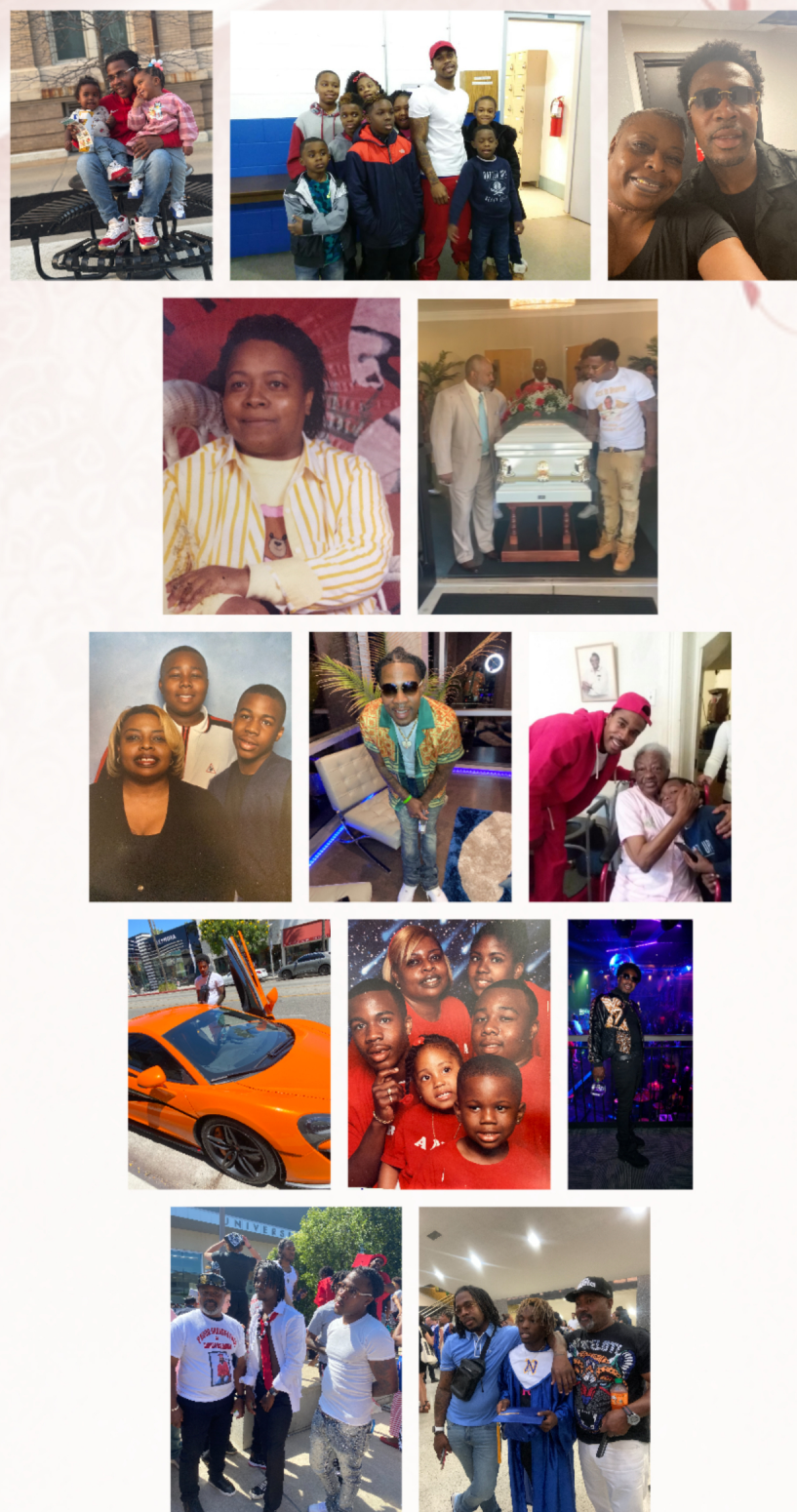
Aaron and his brother, Airrick "Dapp" Rosemond, were like water and oil, but their love for one another was undeniable. They always had each other's backs.
