Henry Hayes Jr.

Henry Hayes Jr. (fondly referred to as "Hayes") was born on January 16, 1937, to Pearl Reed and Henry Hayes Sr., in Columbia, South Carolina. Both parents preceded him in death. Also preceded him in death were his two brothers, William Hayes and Woodrow Jordan and his 2nd wife Shirley Hayes. Henry Hayes departed this phenomenal life on February 16, 2026 after a short illness.

Hayes attended Howard Elementary School and Booker T. Washington High School until he decided to enter the United States Air Force. Hayes was a Korean War Veteran and upon discharge spent a short while at home in Columbia and then he married his childhood sweetheart Doris (Thompson), of Ridgewood, South Carolina. They later relocated to Brooklyn, NY for better employment opportunities. After relocating he was employed at Grand Chromium Plating Corporation for a few years. After his few years at Grand Chromium he was referred to IBM Inc., where he began his illustrious career until his retirement in the early 90's. After his retirement Hayes relocated to Norfolk, Virginia with his longtime partner Shirley, whom he later married. He later resigned with his niece, Sharda (John) Dugger.

Mr. Hayes leaves to cherish his memories one daughter, Dolores Hayes of New York, and one son Jovan Hayes of Maryland. His stepdaughter Barbara of Virginia, 4 grandchildren, Newkema, Zipporah, Lacquavia of New York and Jada of Maryland, 2 sisters Barbara and Julia of South Carolina.
