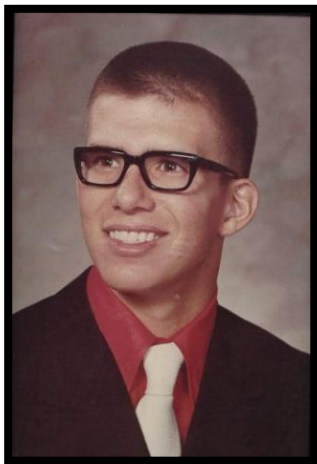
In Loving Memory

Keith Alan Evans, 72, passed away on Thursday, June 11, 2026, at Southfield Wellness community where he had resided for the past two years.
