A Time To Live:

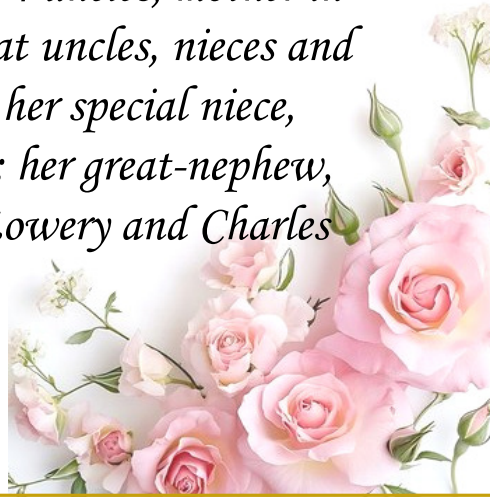
