

Life Reflections

Sarah E. Conyers-Charles was born on November 23, 1941, in Sumter, South Carolina. The only girl among four brothers, she learned strength and resilience early in life. At age 18, after visiting New York City, she made the bold decision to move there permanently — a choice that would shape the rest of her life.

She settled in Harlem, where she raised her children Irene and Eugene. While in New York, Sarah became a certified nurse’s aide, earning her certificate and dedicating herself to caring for others — a reflection of her deep love for family and service. During that time, she met her neighbor Richard Charles, whom she later married. Together they welcomed daughters Victoria and Makeba, and the family later made their home in East Harlem for many years.

In 1994, Sarah returned to Wedgefield, South Carolina, to care for her ailing mother, Willow — a testament to how important family was to her. Her home was always a gathering place, with tables in both the kitchen and dining room where cousins, friends, and loved ones would sit, share meals, and reconnect.

Sarah was preceded in death by her parents, Sam and Willow Conyers; her brothers; her daughter Irene; and her husband Richard Charles.

She leaves to cherish her memory her son Eugene Brown; daughters Victoria and Makeba Charles; granddaughter Juanita Conyers; great-grandchildren Nova and Noah Fulton; and a host of extended relatives and lifelong friends who will remember her strength, devotion, and unwavering love for family.
