Malcolm Dominique Johnson, beloved son, brother, family member, and friend, was born on October 23, 1996, in Newport News, Virginia, to Charles and Claudia Johnson. He departed this life far too soon, leaving behind a legacy of kindness, loyalty, and quiet strength.

Malcolm spent part of his childhood in Las Vegas, Nevada, where he lived for twelve years before relocating to Columbia, South Carolina, in 2012. He graduated from Blythewood High School in 2015 and attended Coastal Carolina University, where he pursued a Bachelor's degree in Biology Engineering.
