She was a tough cowgirl among her brothers, Verne, Eugene, Leonard, and Ernest. During her elementary years, she rode horseback to school and boarded in Bison for high school. She was elected as Homecoming Queen and graduated in 1946.

Her future husband, Martin (Zeke) Allart was discharged from the Navy and they later married July 8, 1946. To this union, three children were born-William (Bill), Linda, and Bret. They made their home south of Bison for the next 45 years where she loved Quarter Horses and passed that legacy down for many generations.

While raising her children and ranching, she attained an Elementary Education Degree from Black Hills Teachers College in Spearfish, SD, with an emphasis in Art.
