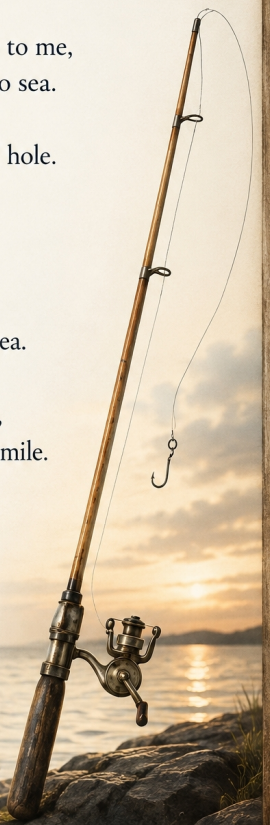
Gone Fishing
