

Beginning with the "G" marker in the grass at the bottom left of the accompanying picture, there are 4 rows which have 8, 2, 7 and 7 headstones or markers respectively. The following information starts at the bottom and continues across each row left-to-right. Women's names are their maiden names. Wives are traditionally buried to the left of their husbands. The information in this file is as of May 1, 2023.

Row 1

1. Fanny M. Kulp 7-13-1897 to 1-31-1981. She married Aaron S. Gingrich.
2. Aaron S. Gingrich 12-29-1894 to 8-25-1952. He is the son of patriarch Aaron Gingrich 10-29-1863 to 6-30-1931.
3. Gladys M. Gingrich 8-29-1921 to 2-03-2003. She is the daughter of Aaron S. Gingrich and married Clair Luther Gable.
4. Clair Luther Gable 12-28-1921 to 2-28-1966.
5. Arlene G. Gernert 9-15-1926 to 6-04-2008. She married Howard F. Gingrich.
6. Howard F. Gingrich 10-28-1919 to 3-14-1997. He is the son of Ammon H. Gingrich.
7. Katie Ann Flory 7-23-1897 to 6-26-1982. She married Ammon H. Gingrich.
8. Ammon H. Gingrich 11-11-1898 to 10-27-1944. He is the son of patriarch Aaron Gingrich.

Row 2

1. Ammon R. (Dick) Gingrich 6-13-1936 to 7-30-1992. He is the son of Ammon H. Gingrich and is husband to Carol A. Remlinger who is living.
2. Norman John Gingrich 12-10-1917 to 3-20-1949. He is the son of Ammon H. Gingrich. He married Helene Anna McAfferly and is father to a daughter.

Row 3

1. Barbara Ann Sellers 9-27-1861 to 4-07-1946. She is the matriarch of the Gingrich family.
2. Aaron Gingrich 10-29-1863 to 6-30-1931. He is the patriarch of the Gingrich family, and is referred to in this document as "Aaron" with no middle initial.
3. Mary Jane Gingrich 7-29-1884 to 7-01-1953. She married Harry Hershey Burkholder 2-26-1883 to 2-28-1950 and they had two sons Melvin U. Burkholder 10-16-1928 to 1-30-2003 and Harry H. Burkholder Jr. Melvin is buried across the driveway from the Gingrich plots and married Shirley I. Rhoads (9-15-1936 - Present).
4. Brandt Gingrich 4-07-1927. Infant son of Howard S. Gingrich and Florence M. Brandt.
5. Barbara Ann Gingrich 10-09-1932. Infant daughter of Howard S. Gingrich and Florence M. Brandt.
6. Florence Mae Brandt 8-21-1900 to 8-08-1953. She married Howard S. Gingrich and is Milton's mother.
7. Howard S. Gingrich 2-28-1902 to 5-01-1971. He is the son of patriarch Aaron Gingrich and is Milton's father.

Row 4

1. Elizabeth A. Shepler 10-15-1967 to Present. She married Douglas H. Gingrich.
2. Douglas H. Gingrich 8-25-1959 to 2-05-2015. He is the son of Howard F. Gingrich.
3. Sara Ann Lehman 3-02-1937 to 4-10-2012. She married Milton H. Gingrich.
4. Milton H. Gingrich 12-08-1937 to Present. He is the son of Howard S. Gingrich.
5. Randall R. Kelly 8-04-1952 to 2-19-1996. He is the son of Bernice M. Gingrich.
6. Bernice Mae Gingrich 10-15-1928 to 12-08-1997. She is the daughter of Howard S. Gingrich.
7. Etta B. Horning Gingrich 5-27-1917 to 12-19-2007. She is the second wife of Howard S. Gingrich.

Note 1

Aaron and Barbara (at the beginning of the third row) are the patriarch and matriarch of the family. Their children Aaron S., Ammon H., Howard S. and Mary are buried in the Campbelltown United Christian Church (UCC) Cemetery. Two other children are:

Emma Gingrich 9-28-1885 to 3-17-1926. She is buried in nearby Elizabethtown, Pennsylvania.
Sellers Gingrich 10-3-1889 to 1-30-1934. He is buried in Hershey, Pennsylvania.

Note 2

Buried in the Campbelltown UCC Cemetery - but not in the Gingrich section - are the parents, grandparents and great-grandparents of Florence Mae Brandt (mother to Milton and Bernice):

Parents of Florence

Isaac M. Brandt 7-15-1861 to 2-14-1939 and Mary Landis Gruber 10-19-1892 to 5-23-1902. Isaac is the son of Levi C. Brandt.

Grandparents of Florence

Levi C. Brandt 11-6-1835 to 9-19-1893 and Mary A. Mumma 8-17-1832 to 2-23-1901. Mary Mumma is the daughter of Isaac Stoner Mumma.

Great-Grandparents of Florence

Isaac Stoner Mumma 4-10-1809 to 10-20-1894 and Catharine Kreider 10-07-1809 to 1-19-1879. Catherine is the daughter of Jacob Kreider and Maria "Mary" Stauffer Kreider.

Great-Great-Grandparents of Florence Not Buried in Campbelltown

Catherine Kreider's parents are not buried in the Campbelltown UCC Cemetery: Jacob Kreider 8-17-1772 to 2-12-1852 and Maria "Mary" Stauffer 2-02-1777 to 2-07-1850. Research for this summary did not determine where Jacob is buried.

Maria "Mary" Stauffer is buried in a Kreider family cemetery referred to as the "Old Kreider Cemetery" or the "Laudermilch Farm Cemetery". It is in a North Cornwall Township Pennsylvania field near Snitz Creek southwest of the City of Lebanon. Denise Witwer Lahr preserved much of the history for the Kreider cemetery. The cemetery ID is 2343504. Map coordinates: 40.32302 N, -76.44138 W

Note 3

Also buried in the Campbelltown UCC Cemetery - but not in the Gingrich section - are Milton's great-grandparents who were parents to Barbara Ann Sellers:

John Sellers 9-19-1833 to 6-07-1891 and Elizabeth Gingerich 12-01-1832 to 6-05-1915. Elizabeth's parents were John Gingerich and Mary Detweiler.

Research for this summary did not determine details for John Gingerich and Mary Detweiler.

Note 4

Elizabeth L. Hetrich - Aaron Gingrich's mother and therefore Milton's great-grandmother - is buried in the Palmyra Cemetery (ID 1970076) between Cherry and Maple Streets near the 700 block of West Main Street in Palmyra, Pennsylvania. Her parents were Levi Hetrich 10-18-1822 to 8-12-1895 and Jane Martha Earley 12-28-1822 to 12-10-1901. They are buried in Shells Cemetery, Shellsville, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, Coordinates 40.37190, -76.675.

Note 5

Aaron's father - Aaron B. Gingrich 5-19-1843 to 6-11-1886 - is buried in Mount Zion Cemetery, Quincy Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania.

Aaron's grandmother Anna Balsbaugh 7-26-1798 to 12-23-1868 is buried in the Balsbaugh Cemetery in Hanoverdale, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania. Cemetery ID: 2620744 Coordinates: 40.32794 N, -76.68546 W. Anna's parents were Valentine Balsbaugh 1755 to 1851 and Elizabeth Miller 1753 to 1821.

Aaron's grandfather was Peter Gingrich Sr. 3-04-1796 to 10-28-1864. He is buried with his wife Anna Balsbaugh Gingrich. Peter's father was Christian Gingrich.


Aaron's great-grandfather, Christian Gingrich 2-19-1752 to 8-02-1808, is buried in the Gingrich Homestead Cemetery in South Annville Township, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania (ID 24163486) on South Mt. Pleasant Road, Coordinates: 40.27671 N, -76.52720 W. The cemetery is very close to the current Lebanon Valley Bible Church. Christian's wife Anna Hostetter 1763-1837 is buried with him. The photo below lists the other family members buried there:



Finally, Aaron's great-great-grandparents were Joseph "Yost" or "Jost" Gingerich 1712 to 3-06-1776 and Anna Huber Gingerich 1715 to 1802.

"Yost was born in Canton Berne, Switzerland. After Mennonites were expelled from Switzerland in 1712 for not being willing to join the army. Many moved to the German Palatinate. They were unable by law to purchase the land they farmed. When William Penn offered settlements to European Christians to come to live in peace, owning their own land. Mennonites and Amish took up the offer and in 1717 they began migrating to Lancaster and beyond. Joseph Gingerich was one of thousands that took up the offer and brought his family and faith to the New World. Pictured below is the hand drafted front piece of the Martyrs Mirror, it has Joseph(Yost) name. It is located in the Muddy Creek Pennsylvania Library and archive. These stories of Christian martyrs were highly prized by the Mennonites as it often told the stories of their ancestors and spiritual fathers who suffered in the 15 and 1600s for their version of Christianity."
