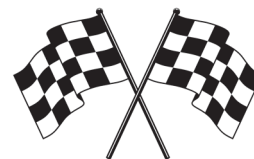
He was preceded in death by his grandparents, Ruby L and Thomas Wiley Rushing and Willie Alton and Ida Scheide Reynolds.

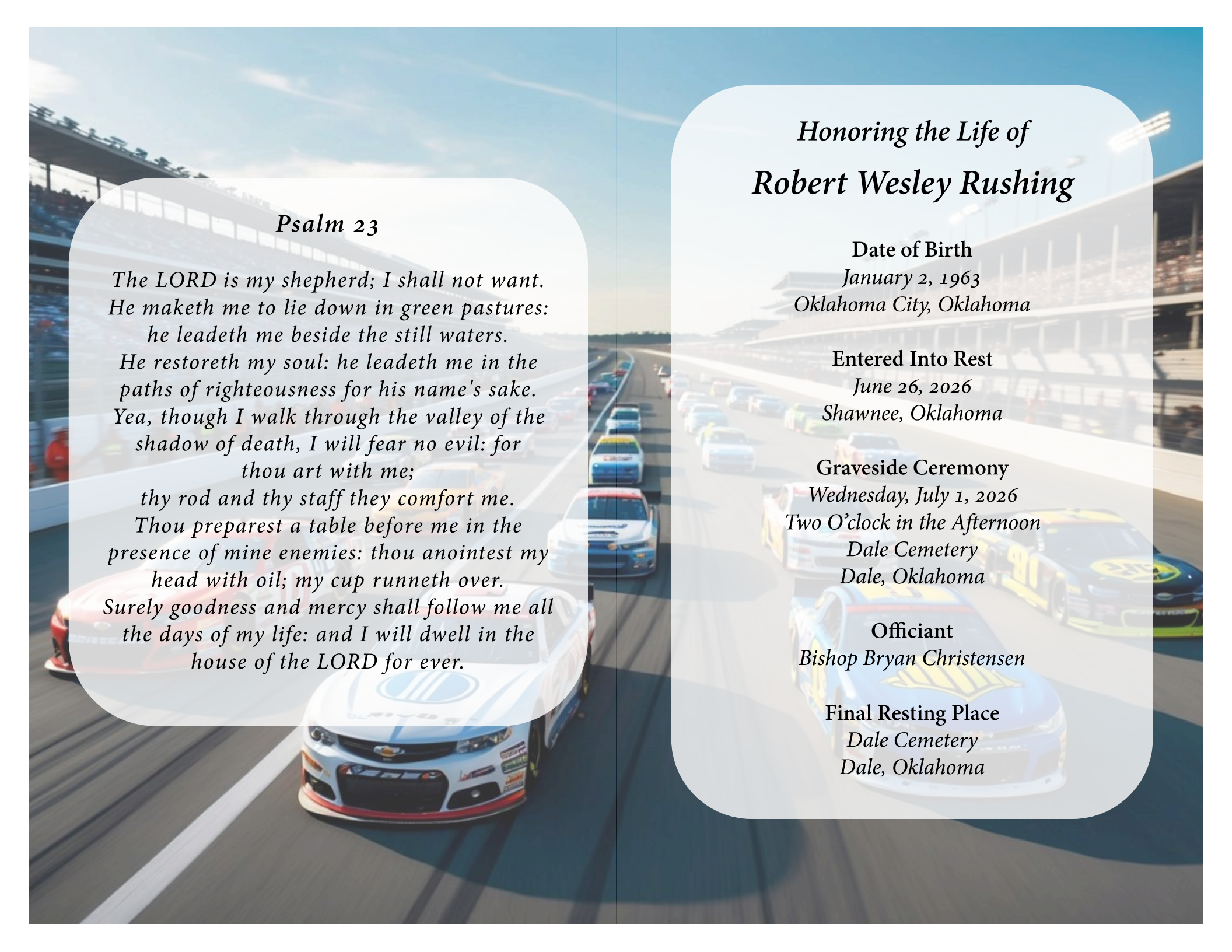
