But you have passed the ultimate test

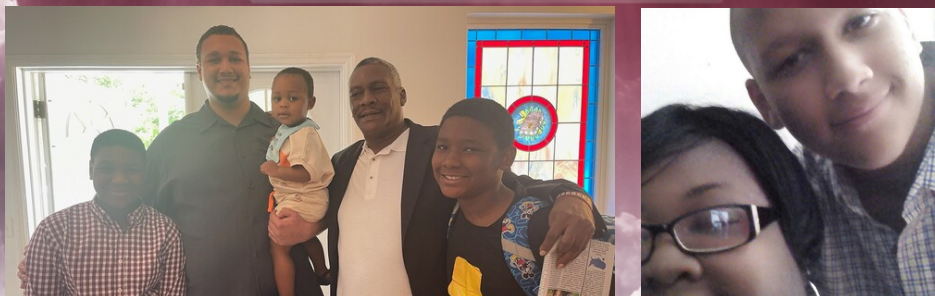
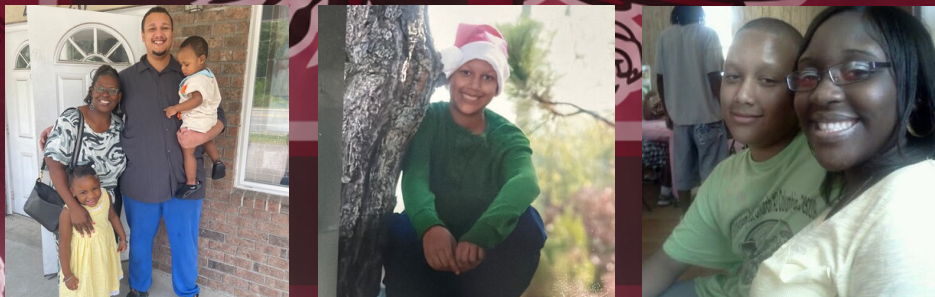
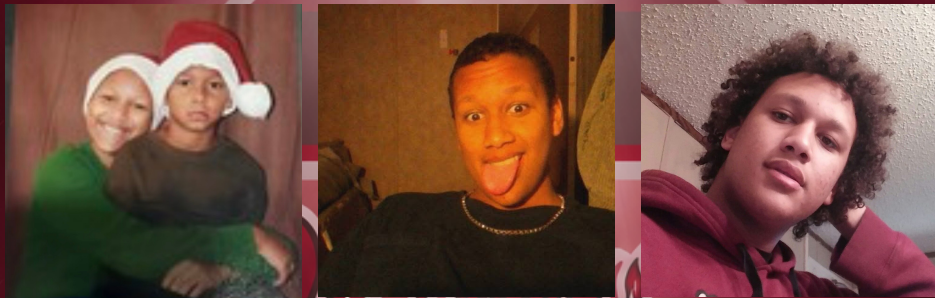
