On his spare time he would make beadwork crafts, frybread & skillet rounds. Tim was very kind hearted. Always helping someone in need when he could.

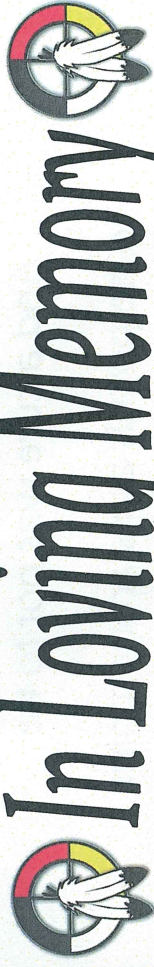
