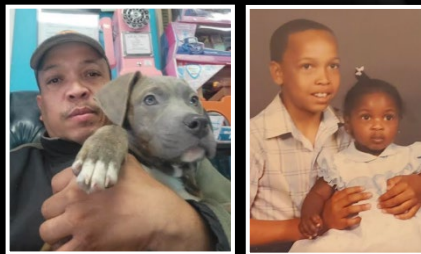

Elvis Presley Wilburn Jr., departed from his physical life on earth May 10, 2026, leaving behind a legacy of laughter, kindness, and love for his family and friends.

Elvis was born on September 29, 1977, in Jackson, MS to parents Elvis Presley Wilburn Sr. and Donna Cooper Andrews. Elvis was raised in Eden, MS. He graduated from Yazoo City High School in 1996 and later studied welding at Holmes Community College.

Throughout his life, Elvis worked at Atmos Energy for 3 years as a tech. He later worked at the Federal Prison, where he retired in 2010. Elvis spent his last years working as a mechanic for American Automotive. Beyond his professional life, Elvis had a deep passion for repairing vehicles of all kinds. He also loved lawn care.

Elvis touched the lives of many with his profound sense of humor, warmth, creativity, curiosity, and gregarious outgoing nature.
