“The Lord is my shepherd I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures, He leads me beside still waters.” Psalm 23:1-2

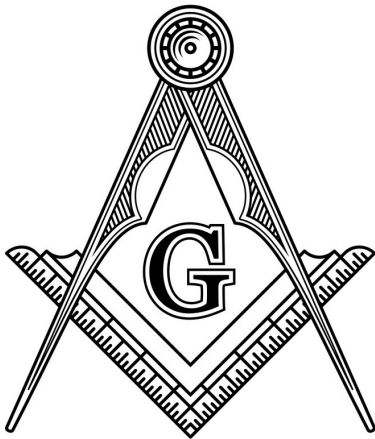
