Brodes received his early education at Richard Allen School and later attended William C Jason Comprehensive High School. He was a part of the last graduating class from Jason...Class of 1967.

Brodes went to work at General Foods, currently known as Kraft Heinz Company. After dedicating a generous amount of time there, Brodes spent the remainder of his career working for Kent Soil and Water Conservation District with the State of Delaware until his retirement. He was also an entrepreneur, serving others through his lawncare and wood delivery businesses.
