

Have I Done Any Good?

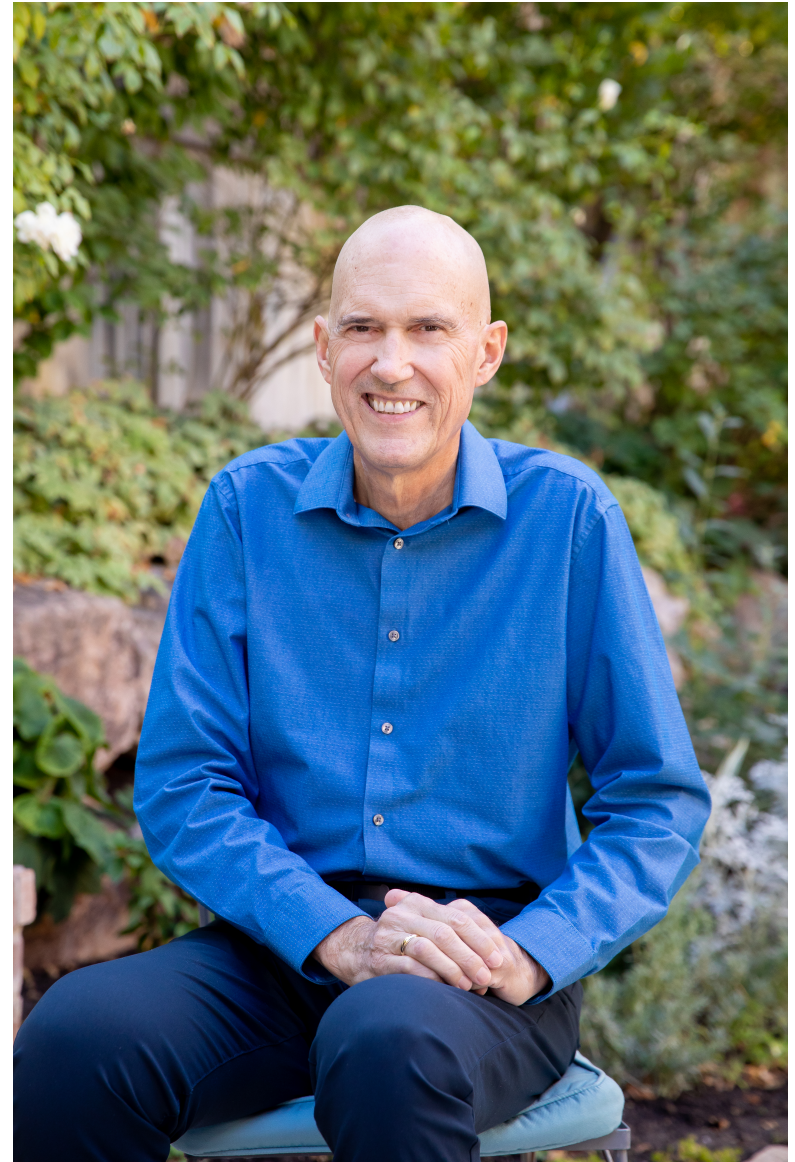
