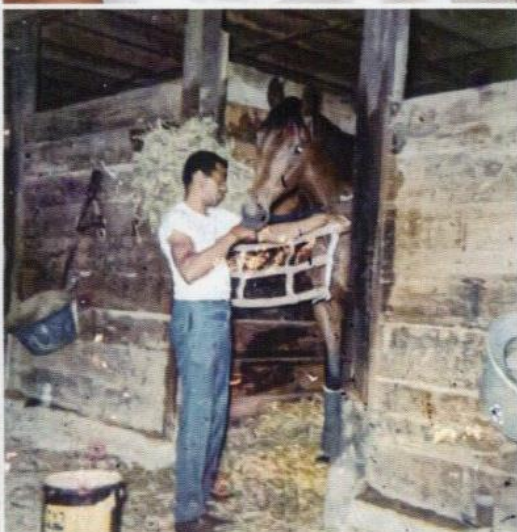
Her children remember her as being kind, happy, and enjoyed life. She was an amazing woman who will be greatly missed.
