A pocket knife, or nails that were bent.

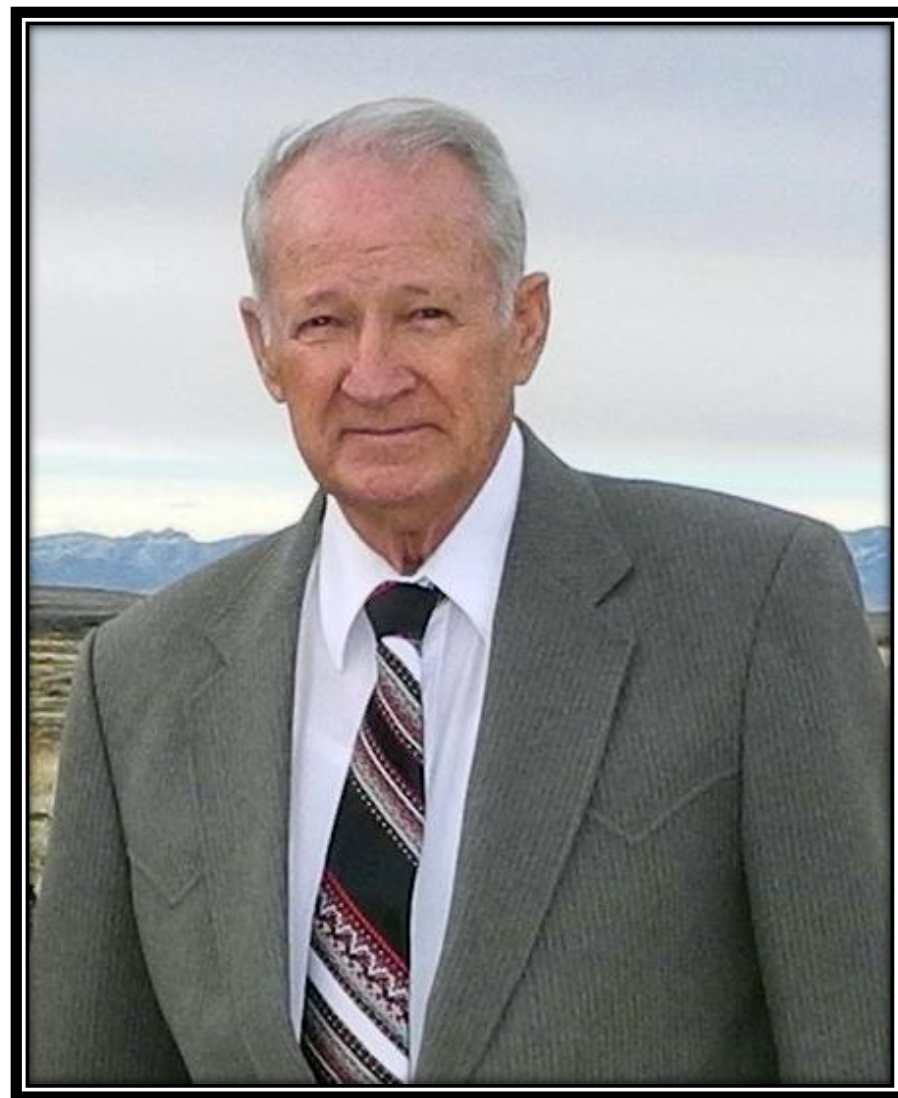
Now to clean Don's pockets, we thought it a curse

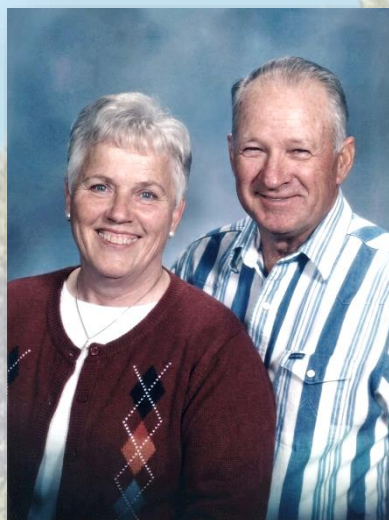
