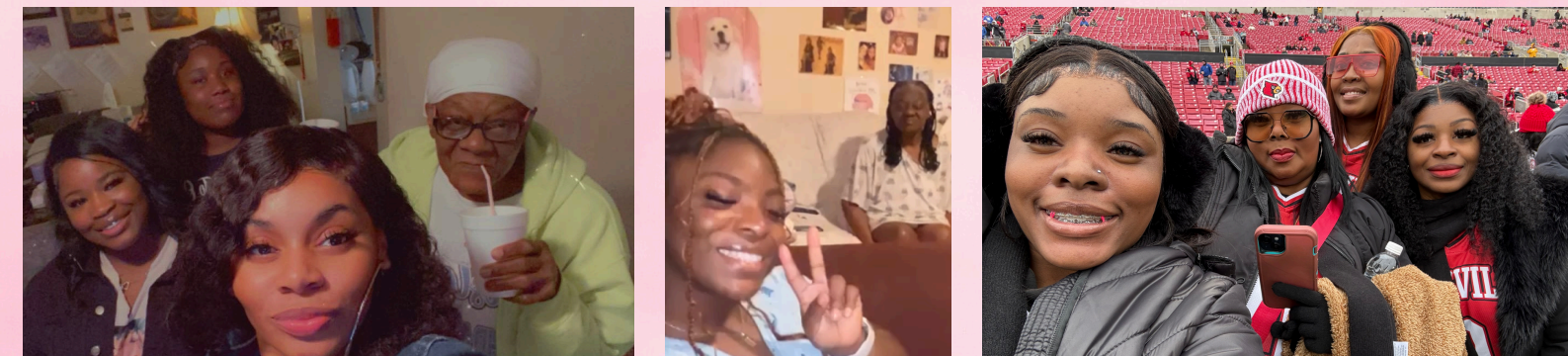
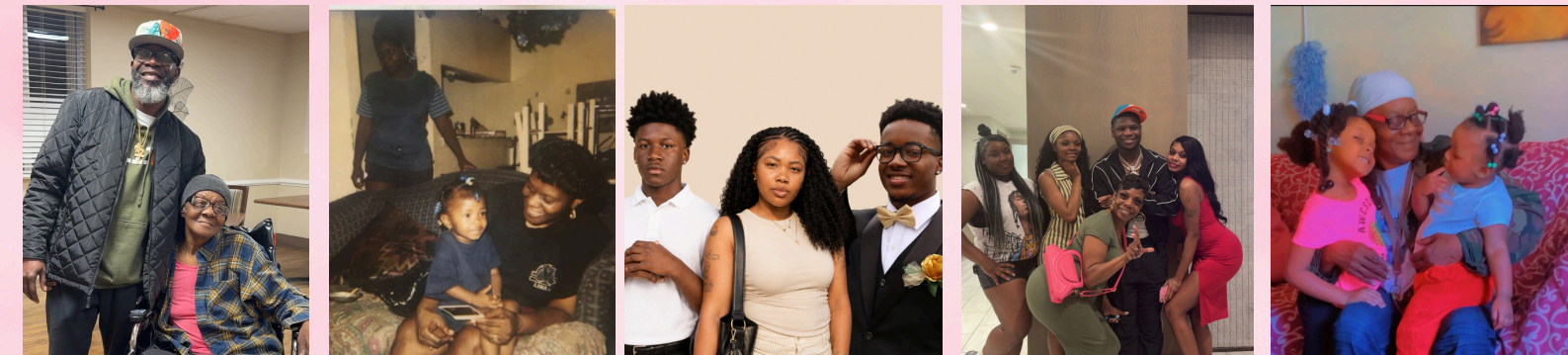
Of all the special gifts in life, however
