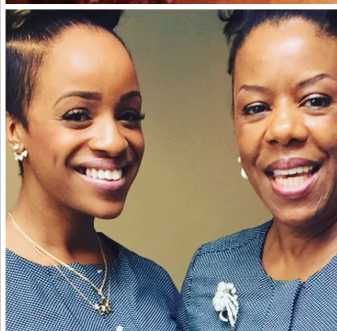

OBITUARY

Elder Rebecca was born in Brooklyn, NY on April 18, 1955 to Eva Jeanetta Angel and Andrew Angel. She attended NYC public schools, graduated from Fashion Industries High School and attended the renowned Fashion Institute of Technology. For the next 10 years Rebecca went on to work for several companies in the fashion industry including: Butterick Patterns, Marion Maged, Maggy London, Evelyn Dejonge, and Geoffrey Beene. Her titles included, Pattern Maker, Sample Cutter, Assistant Designer, Trimmings Buyer and Fitting Model. She then graduated from the Hair Design Institute and pursued, successfully, her natural inclination and passion for Cosmetology. After working with several hair salons, Rebecca continued to freelance as a hair stylist, make-up artist, and fashion/beauty consultant. She created and facilitated seminars entitled, "Looking Like the King's Kid" and "Beauty From The Inside Out."

We all know Rebecca had a passion for cooking and preparing meals and desserts. We will forever miss experiencing her prized pork roast, "you know what" salad, strawberry shortcake, pecan pie, and an endless list of all of her signature dishes.

Rebecca was raised under the leadership of the late Apostle Arturo Skinner, at the Deliverance Evangelistic Center and later on, Apostle Ralph Nichol. She sang in the junior choir and moved on to sing with the 500 voice choir, The Supernatural Voices of Deliverance. Rebecca also graduated from the Deliverance Bible Institute as the Salutatorian of her class. In 1990 she joined the ministry of Apostle R.L. Jackson at The Life Center International Ministries, where she was the choir director and worked on the Women's Ministry. After moving to New Jersey in 2002, Rebecca joined the Agape Family Worship Center in 2004 under the leadership of Dr. Lawrence Powell, and became a member of A'Zamar. In 2013 she was ordained an Elder and later on became involved with and eventually became the lead for the Women's Ministry.

While in Deliverance Evangelistic Center, Rebecca met one of the young ministers named, Mark Turner, and worked along side him at McCrory's 5 and dime in downtown Brooklyn. (We later found out that was a set up by her good friend Patricia Downing) Mark asked her if she would accompany him to his senior prom, as "just friends". 4 years later, they married, and to this union two children were born: Jaime Noelle and Mark Richard. Mark and Rebecca celebrated their 47th anniversary this past June.

Over the last seven years, as Rebecca battled heart disease, she continued to freelance, work with the Women's Ministry, pray for and look after her family, encourage and mentor young ladies, and support her church. Taking a quote from Rebecca: "Pretty is as Pretty does. Stay pretty on the inside....then you won't have to worry so much about the out".
