

Lloyd Edward Hubbard, affectionately known as "Butch," was born on June 4, 1951, in Cincinnati, Ohio, at General Hospital to Emma Louise Williams Hubbard and Lloyd Haskell Hubbard. Reared in the Evanston neighborhood, Butch's childhood was filled with the rhythms of front-porch laughter, the aroma of Sunday dinners, and the steadfast love of a praying mother. He graduated from Withrow High School in the Class of 1969 and went on to study nursing at the University of Cincinnati, answering an early call to serve and to heal.

**Caregiver at Heart:\*\*** Professionally and personally, he cared for others—the elderly, the ill, the overlooked—treating every patient as kin.
