

Wayne Joseph Schiwal

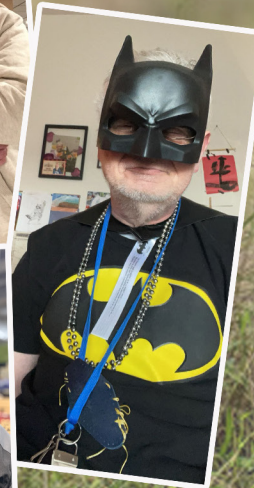
