

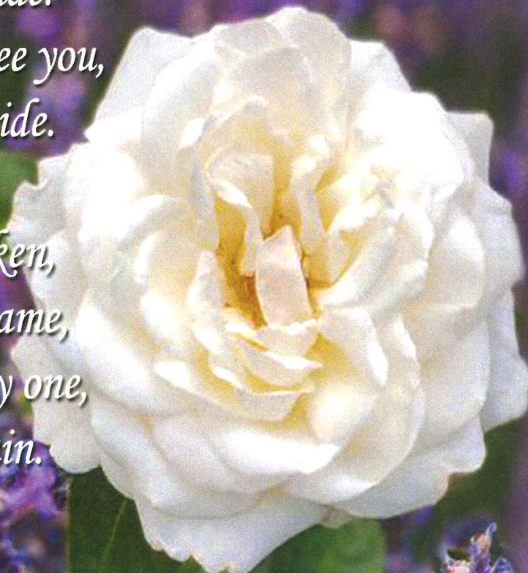
The Broken Chain
