**Jane Noreen Simonson** was born on September 15<sup>th</sup>, 1957, to Norma and Warren “Gabby” Simonson. She grew up as the third of four girls, and her dad would answer the phone “Simonson Hatchery, which chick do you want?” The Simonson girls grew up close, but Jane wasn’t afraid to let them know if they messed up, including tackling one of her sisters when they borrowed her boots. She graduated from Granite Falls High School and attended University of Minnesota, Morris where she received her teaching degree.


