Knowing it would help you stay.

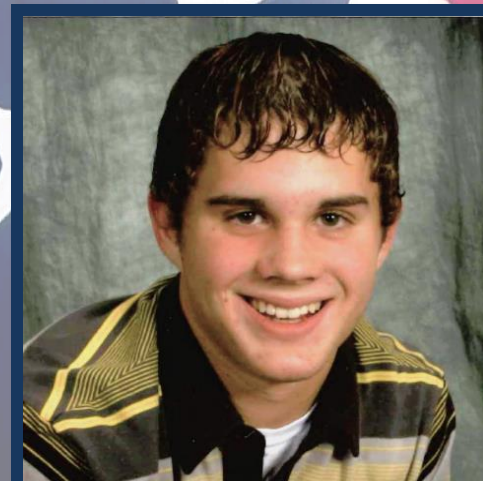
But if you didn't want the miracle
