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Mennonites Explore Mission

3,000 Coming To Conference

*Mission '70," the 64th annual international conference of the Mennonite Board of Missions and Charities, will bring some 3,000 Mennonites to the Delaware Valley, July 1 through 7.

The conference site is the campus of Christopher Dock Mennonite High School, Lansdale.

Because of the heavy concentration of Mennonite families in Montgomery and Bucks counties, the gathering promises to be the best attended in history, according to Henry P. Yoder of Lansdale, chairman of the Local Arrangements and Steering Committee.

"Conference participants will explore every individual's potential role in carrying out the many faceted mission of the church," Yoder said, adding that basic areas of Mennonite concern include brotherhood, service, missionary effort and peace.

Among the speakers will be Delton Franz of the Mennonite Central Committee Peace Section, Washington, D.C., an agency aimed at interpreting to the federal government the Mennonites' philosophy of conscientious objection.

Other speakers will include the Rev. William Pannell of Detroit, a black evangelist and author of "My Friend the Enemy," a book on religion and race, and Sammy Santos, chairman of the Spanish Committee of the Minority Ministries Council, New York City.

Discussion groups sponsored by the Women's Mission and Service Auxiliary will develop into a variety of areas, including "Mennonite Women of the '70s," conducted by Lois Gunter, and "Honest Parent-Teen Relationships," led by Dr. and Mrs. Abraham Schmitt of Souderton.

The conference will include music sessions, Bible study, open discussions of church policy, decision-making meetings of the mission board and activities and field trips for children and youth.

The synod also recommended the presbyteries recognize welfare reform as "their top priority."

The WRO speaks at the synod were Mrs. Roxanne Jones, president of the Philadelphia chapter; Dorothée Burnett, vice president; and Mrs. Pauline London and Mrs. Viola Saunders.

They asked individual congregations to publicize the "facts" surrounding people in need and pressure the state legislature.

Earlier in the day, the synod agreed to undertake a three-year "evangelical advance" program to turn around the decline in membership.

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Nixon Receives 'Churchman' Award
WASHINGTON (UPI)—The Religious Heritage of America Thursday cited President Nixon as the "Churchman of the Year," partly for his precedent-setting Sunday worship services in the White House.

George Romney, secretary of Housing and Urban Development, presented the award to Nixon at the White House, and told him: "You focused attention on the religious crisis in this country."

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
