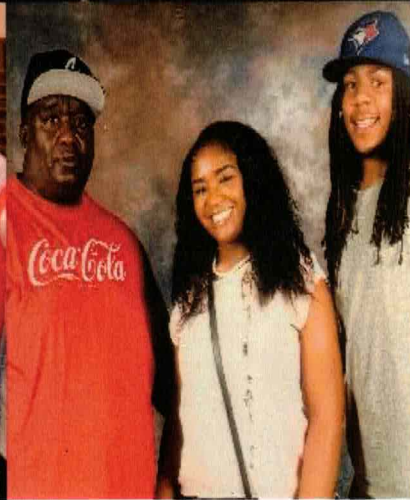
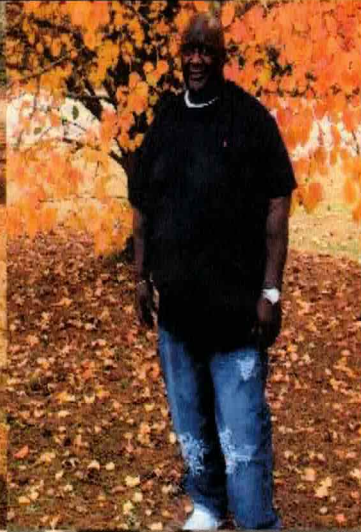
Jammie O'Neil Horne was born on September 29, 1972, to the late James Edward Horne and the late Joyce Ann Horne.

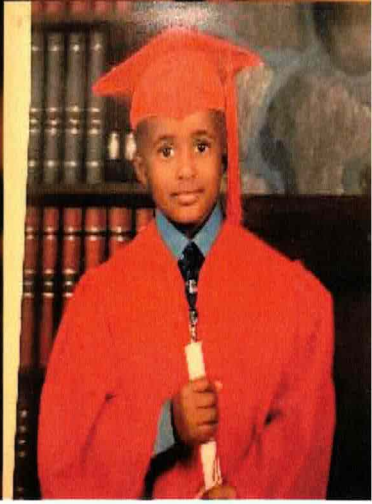
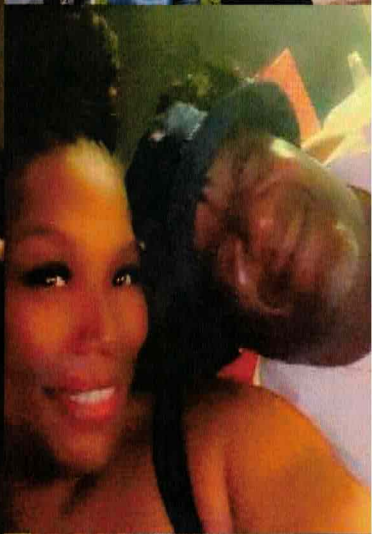
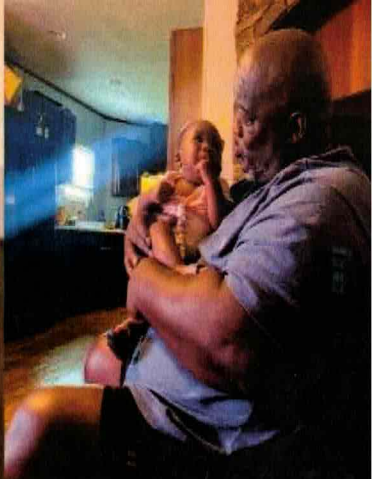
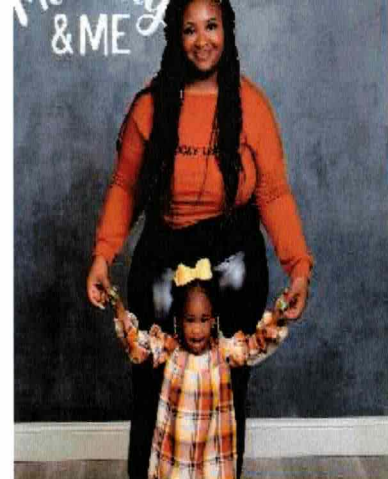

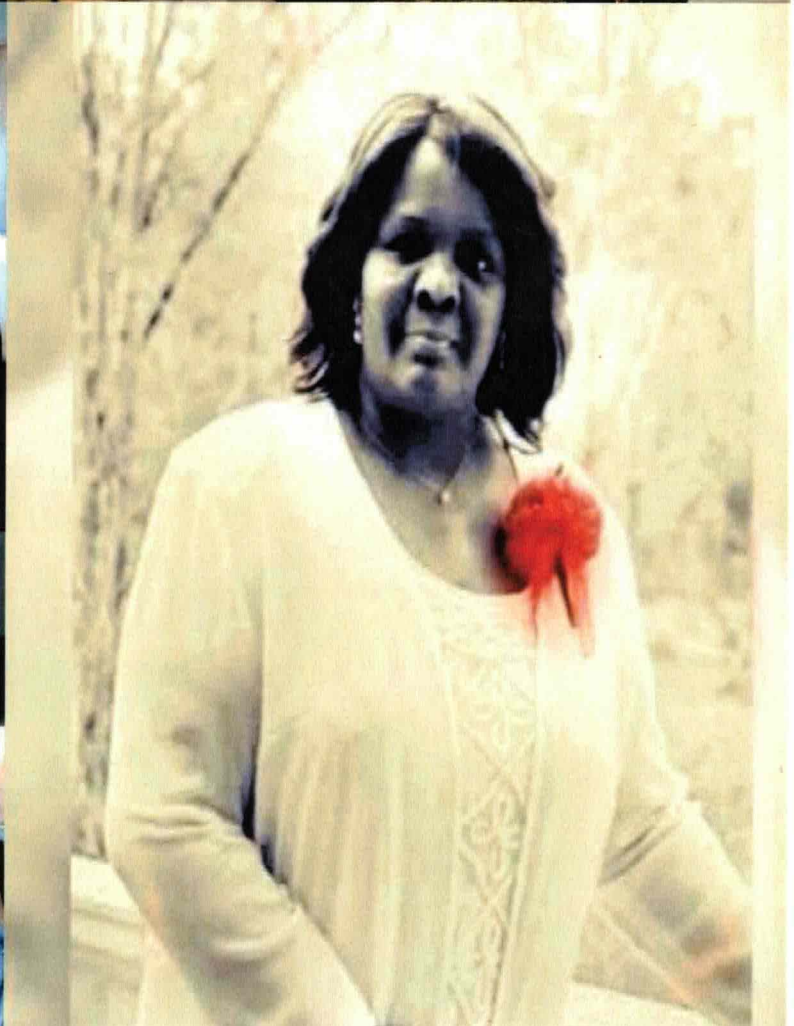
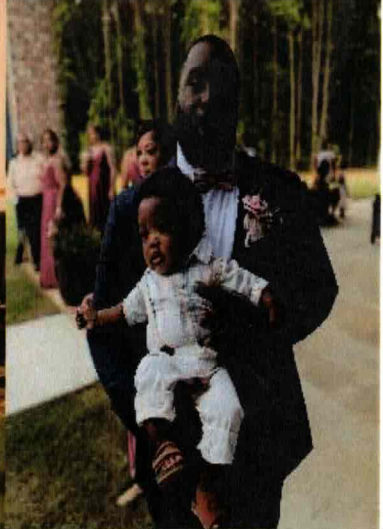
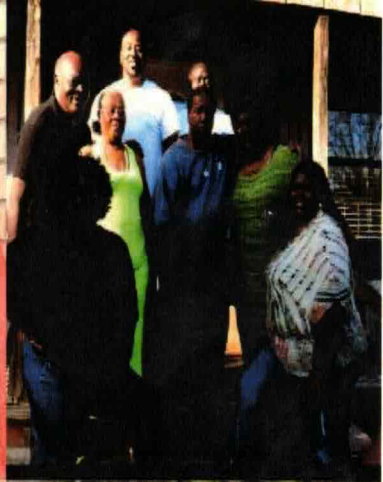
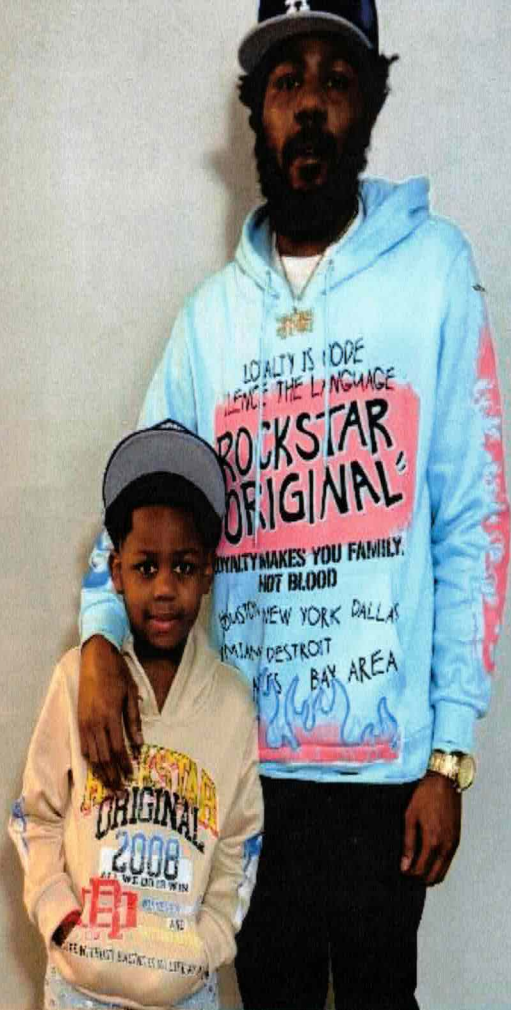
Jammie was preceded in death by his father, James Horne; his mother, Joyce Horne; his sister, Tiffany Horne; and both his maternal and paternal grandparents.
