

Albert Haak was born on April 6, 1936 to Abraham and Cornelia (Van Bommel) Haak in Hills, Minnesota. He was baptized and made profession of faith at Hills Christian Reformed Church. Albert attended Hills Christian Schools and Hills Public Schools. He was enlisted in the United States Army on July 1, 1957 and was honorably discharged on June 30, 1959. On August 18, 1959 Albert was united in marriage to Frances Alice Haan. The couple was blessed with four children as they raised their family in Hills. Albert and Frances lived in Hills for 24 years. In 1965, Albert purchased half interest in Hills Locker Service and worked there for 30 years. In 1982, they moved to an acreage west of Hills where they enjoyed raising stock cows, gardening and mowing their lawn. Albert and Fran enjoyed traveling together including their trips to Mexico, Washington DC and seven countries in Europe.
