

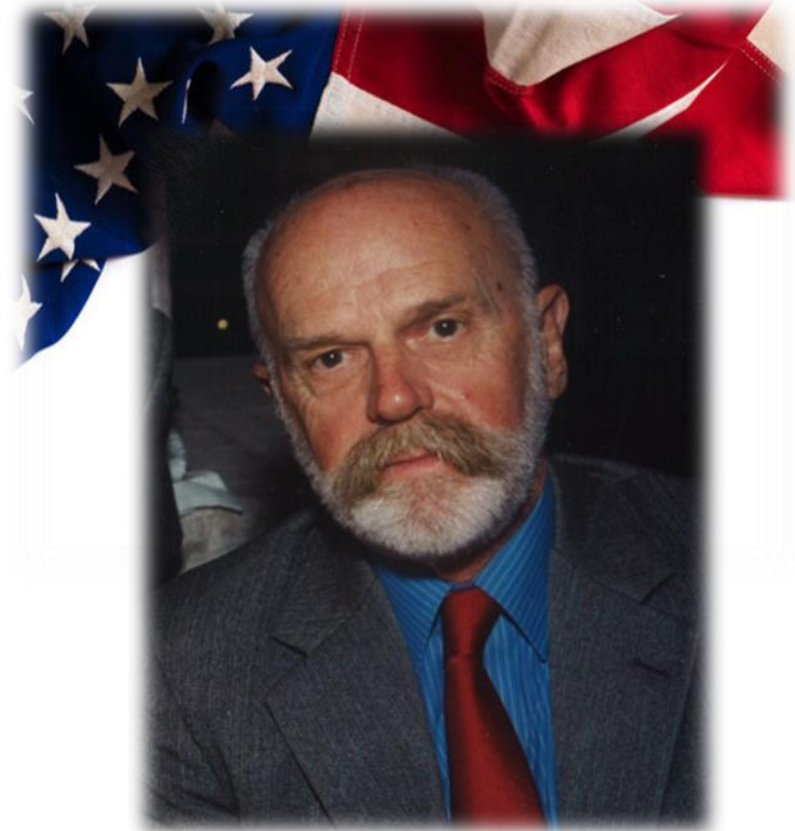
**HAROLD "HAL" DEAN MATTICKS**
