Evelyn was preceded in death by her father and mother Leodis and Mattie Jackson; her son William H. Burton IV; and her daughter Patricia Marie Burton.

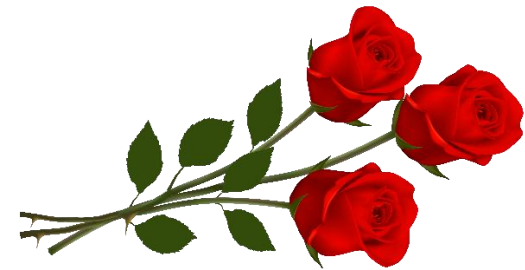
