Remembering Mother Mattie

MATTIE J. WILSON WAS BORN ON MARCH 26, 1933, IN KANSAS CITY, KANSAS TO THE UNION OF ELVIN AND FREDA MAE BAKER. SHE WAS THE FIFTH OF TEN CHILDREN. SHE WAS PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HER PARENTS; THREE SISTERS, FRAYOLA WEBSTER, OLLIE MAE RODGERS AND CLARA HODGE; AND THREE BROTHERS, CLARENCE HODGE, BOBBY BAKER, AND JIMMY BAKER.

MOTHER WILSON RECEIVED HER EDUCATION IN THE KANSAS CITY, KANSAS SCHOOL SYSTEM WHERE SHE WENT ON TO GRADUATE FROM SUMNER HIGH SCHOOL, FURTHERING HER EDUCATION BY OBTAINING AN ASSOCIATE'S DEGREE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION WHILE PURSUING A CAREER IN PROFESSIONAL DANCING.

SHE THEN MARRIED HER HIGH SCHOOL SWEETHEART, DEACON EDWARD WILSON SR, AND FROM THIS UNION FOUR CHILDREN WERE BORN. SHE WAS A VERY LOVING AND DEVOTED WIFE AND MOTHER.

MOTHER WILSON WAS RAISED IN A CHRISTIAN HOME, ACCEPTING CHRIST AT AN EARLY AGE, AND WAS THEN BAPTIZED AT TRINITY AME METHODIST CHURCH IN KANSAS CITY, KANSAS. SHE LATER JOINED ST. PAUL MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH IN KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, UNDER THE PASTORSHIP OF REV. CALVIN K. BUFORD, WHERE SHE WAS A DEVOTED MEMBER FOR OVER 20 YEARS. SHE WAS A DEDICATED MEMBER OF THE MOTHER BOARD AT ST. PAUL, AND FAITHFULLY SERVED AS THE MOTHER BOARD'S CORRESPONDING SECRETARY.

SHE WAS A VERY KIND, GENTLE, AND SOFT SPOKEN WOMAN, ENDURING THAT SPECIAL AND EVERLASTING SMILE TO ALL SHE ENCOUNTERED AND WAS SURROUNDED WITH. IN ADDITION, SHE LOVED HER FAMILY DEARLY AND WAS EAGER TO SHARE HER FAITH WITH FAMILY AND FRIENDS. ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 18, 2025, THE LORD CALLED MOTHER MATTIE WILSON HOME TO ETERNAL REST.







REMEMBER ME NOT JUST IN THE DAYS




Loving Memories
