When your tummy aches.*

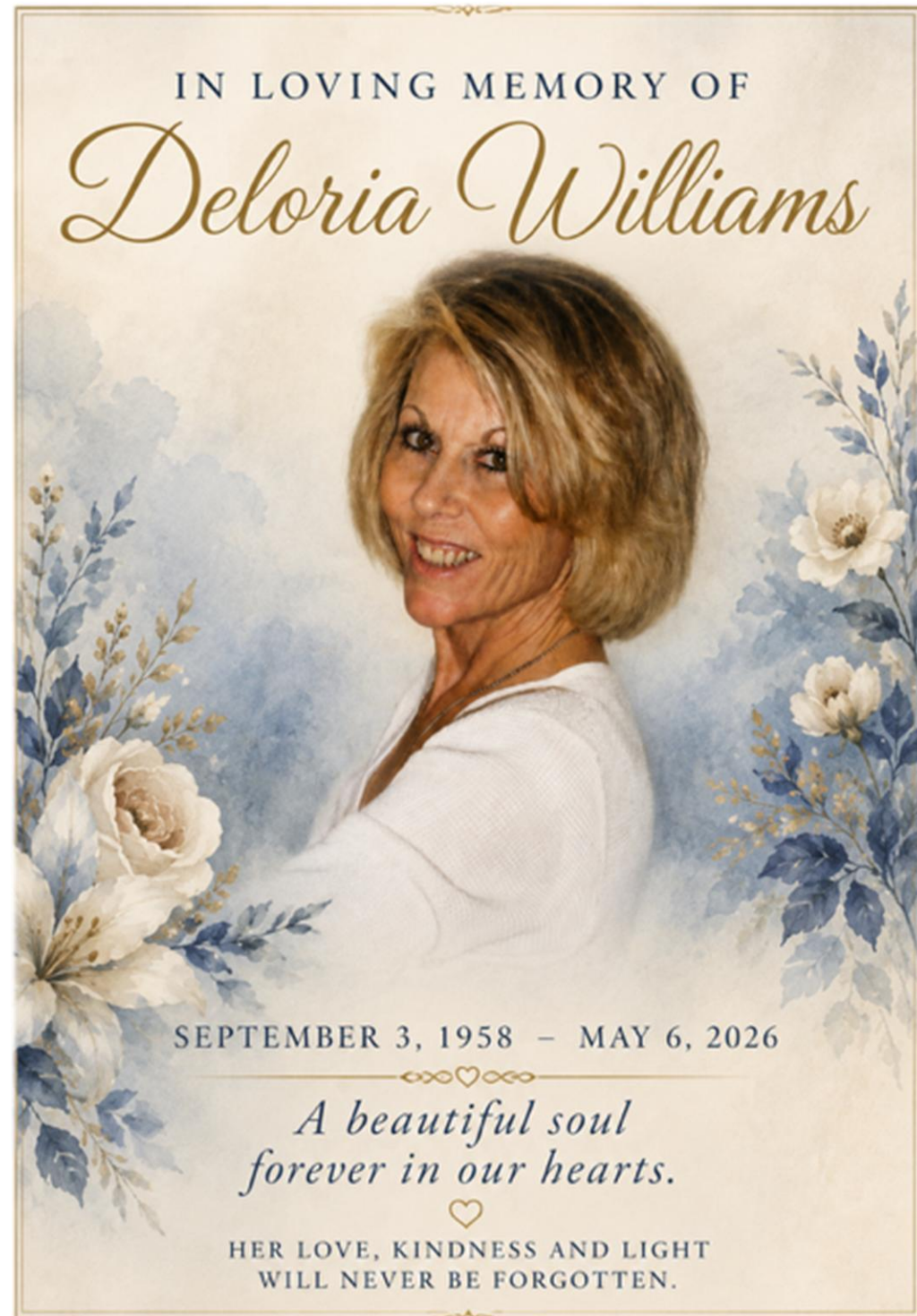
*Mothers are for watching
