

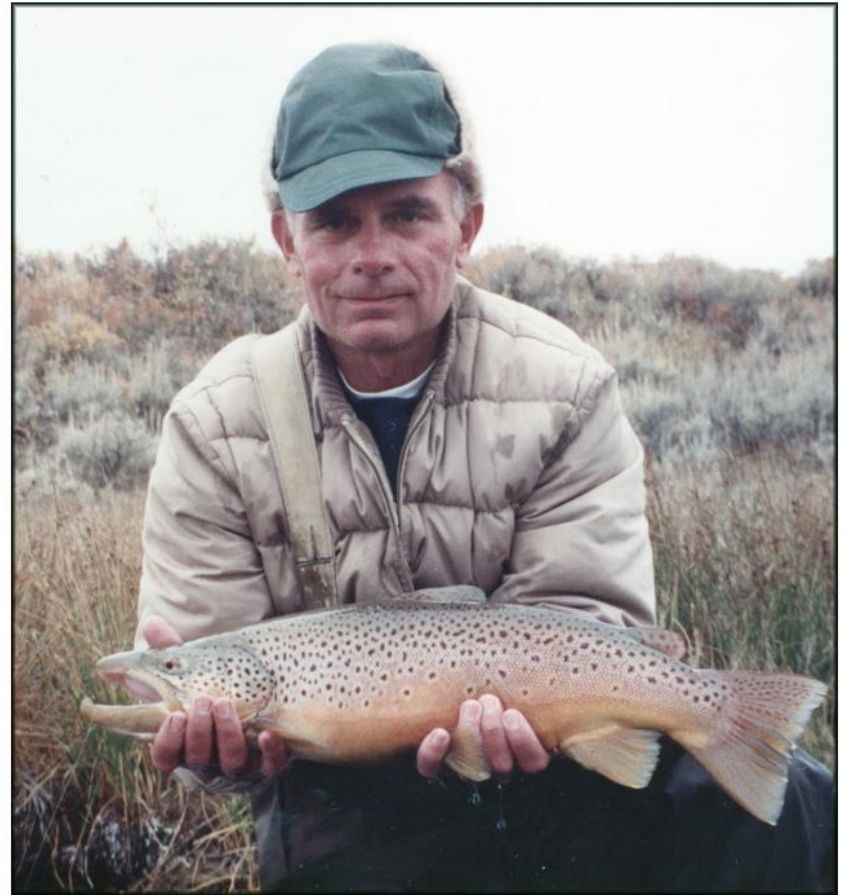
HE ONLY TAKES THE BEST
