Sergeant Jadyn Gabrielle Alyse Bond was born on August 23rd, 2003 in Overland Park, KS to John Bond and Maranda Neely-Bond. From a young age, she filled every space she entered with energy, laughter, and a fearless spirit. Jadyn was educated in the Kansas City, Kansas Public school district, ultimately receiving her high school diploma from Sumner Academy of Arts & Sciences.

A passionate athlete, Jadyn excelled in basketball, martial arts, softball, track, wrestling and even roller skating. Jadyn had a burning interest in music, teaching herself to play the guitar in her teenage years. In her high school years, she became a pioneer in female wrestling becoming the 1st novice champion and 1st female state qualifier at Sumner Academy.

In March of 2022, Jadyn proudly enlisted in the United States Army, quickly rising to the rank of Sergeant, while being stationed in Fayetteville, North Carolina. Her humor, determination, and boundless love for her family and friends defined her. Jadyn departed this life on April 10, 2025. She was preceded in death by her maternal grandmother Estherlene Neely and paternal grandfather David Wilbourn.
