Dale, 51, passed away on December 29, 2011, at the Close to Home Hospice in Gillette.

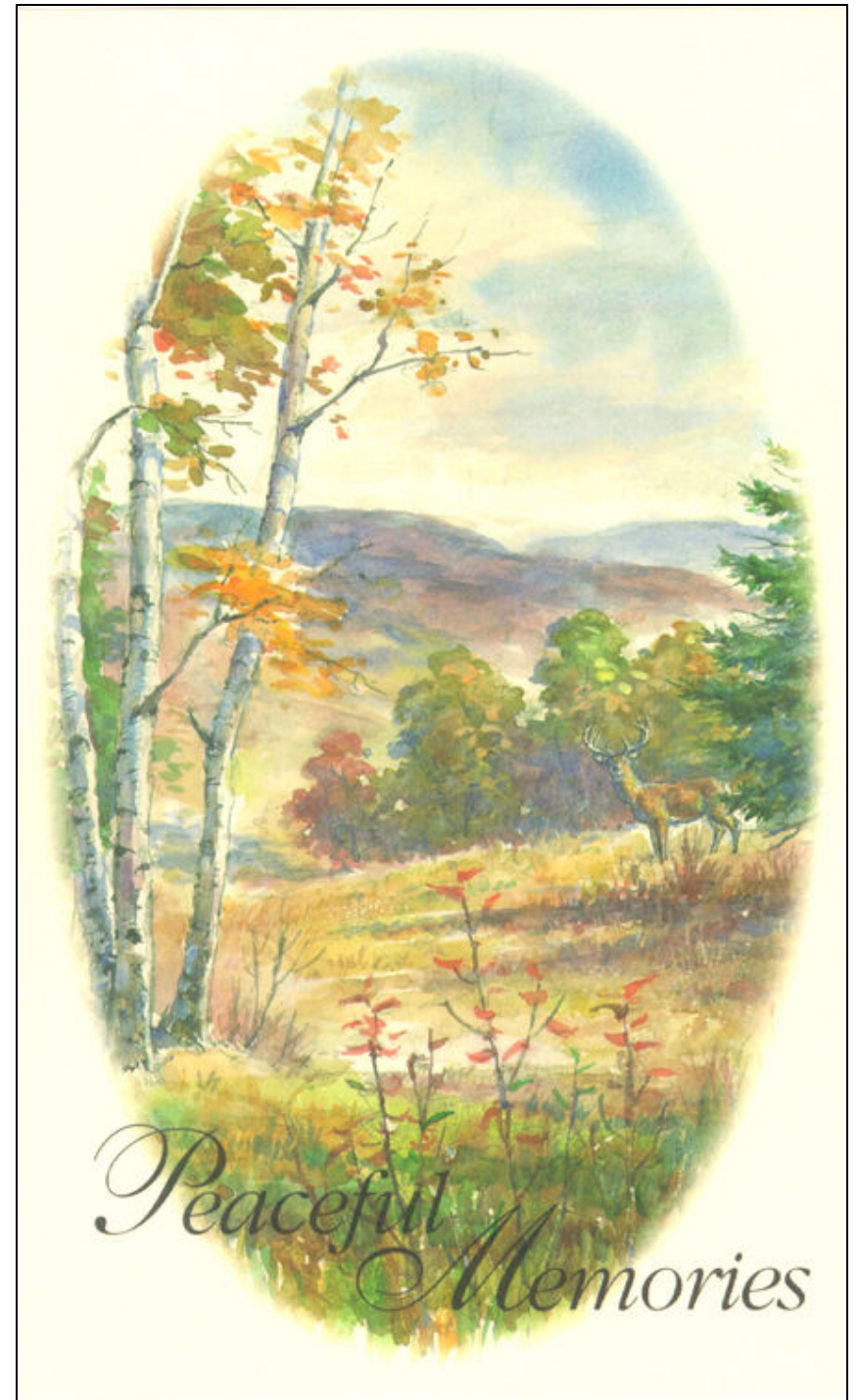
