And you'll find that I've gone riding.

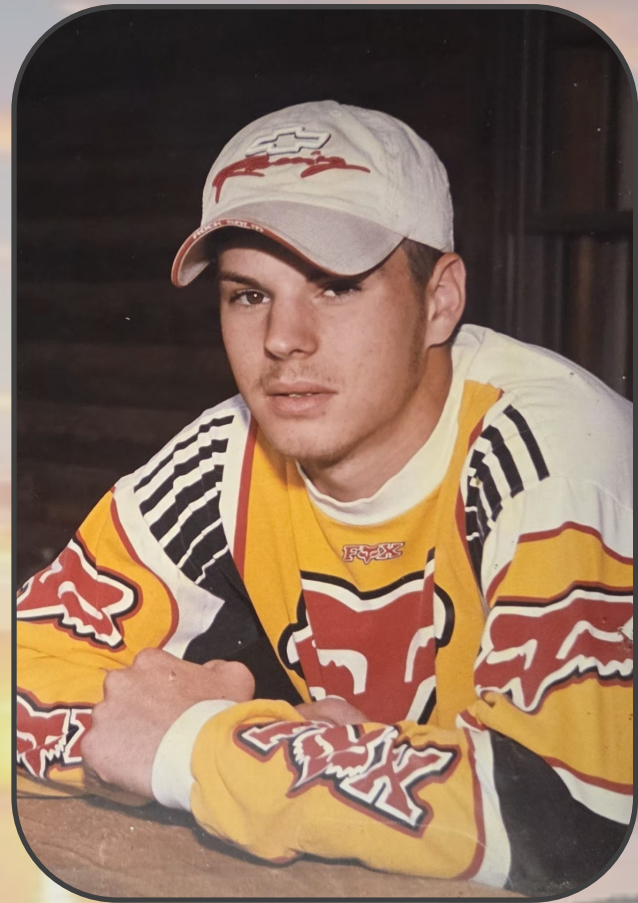
