You must allow him to fix it, even if the item was on its last leg or incapable of being repaired. He was very knowledgeable when it came to fixing things and enjoyed "solving the problem". Another pastime that he had was his love of Marvel characters such as Iron Man aka Tony Starks, X-Men characters like Wolverine were his favorite. He also was into DC Comics and their characters. His favorite was Batman. Vincent even owned a Batman themed adult bicycle which was sadly lost in a house fire in 2018.
