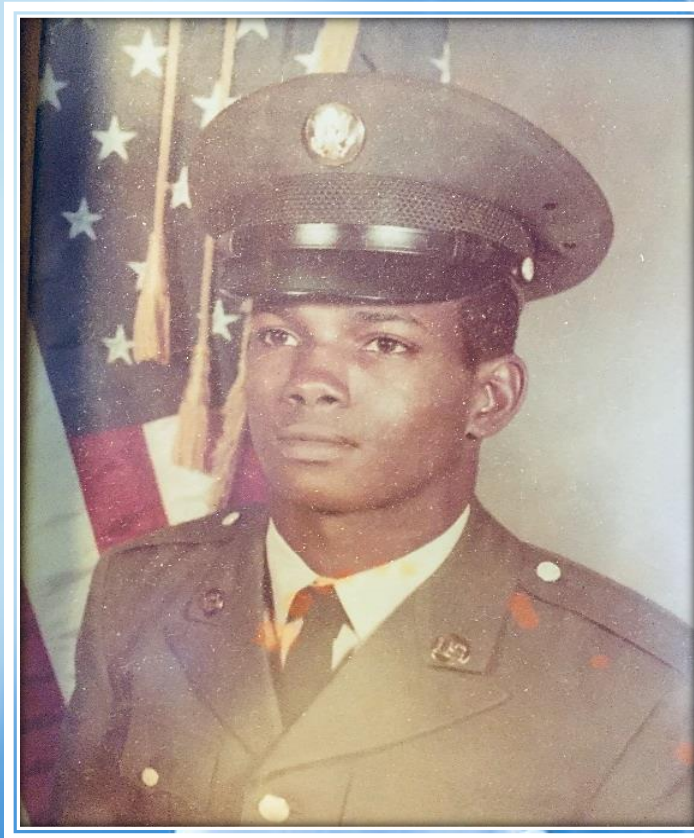

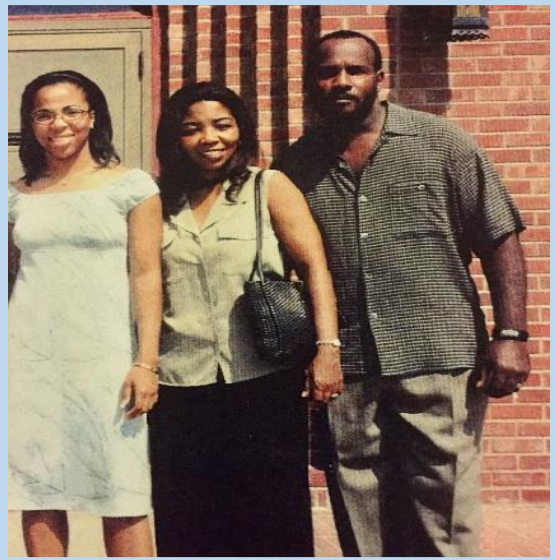
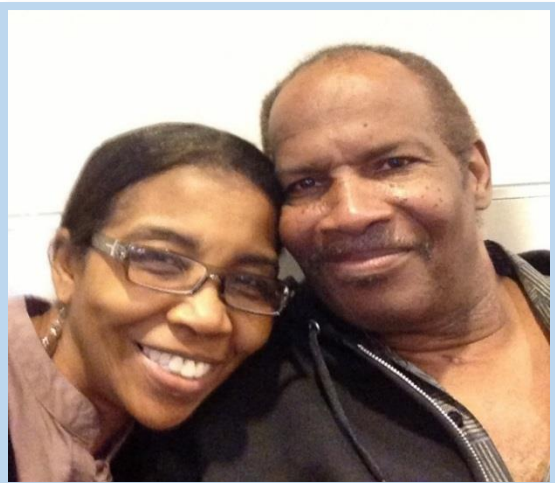
A Tribute to My Husband
