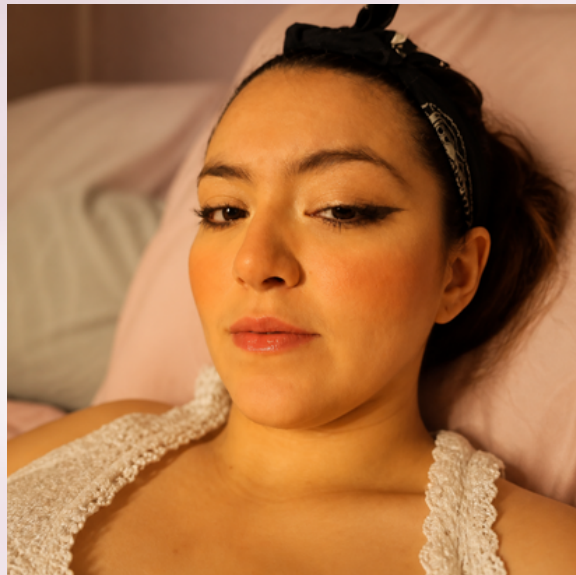

She dreamed of becoming a neurosurgeon, a calling she pursued with determination, curiosity,

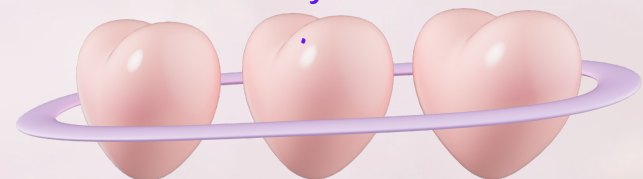
and a passion for learning. She attended South Texas Vocational Technical Institute
