*Her presence will be greatly missed, but her love, faith, and memories will live on forever.*

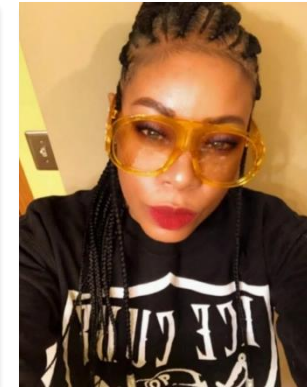
