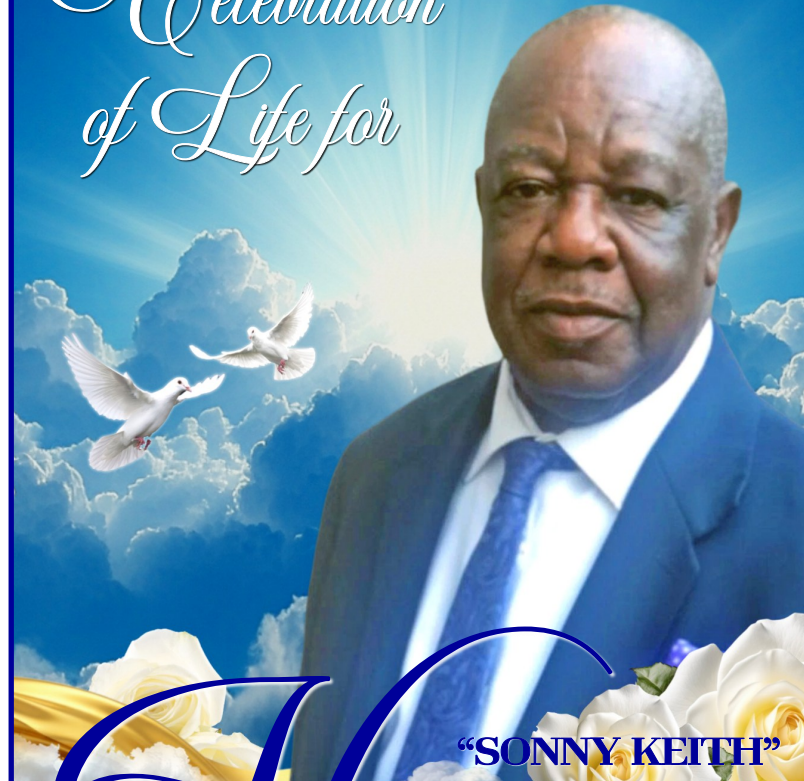

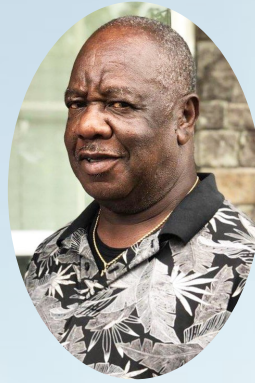

## Reflection of Life

**Henry Keith Blandon**, affectionately known as "Sonny Keith," was born on September 28, 1951, to the late Malachi Sr. and Ida Mae Blandon. On March 18, 2026, he peacefully transitioned into eternal rest with the Lord at Roper St. Francis Hospital in Charleston, South Carolina.

Keith received his education in the Berkeley County public school system and was a proud member of the Russellville High School Class of 1970. At an early age, he accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior and became a devoted member of Good Shepherd Reformed Episcopal Church, where his faith took root.

On September 3, 1982, Keith was united in Holy Matrimony to Ruth Rollerson. Their union was one of love and devotion and was blessed with a daughter, India, who brought him great pride and joy.
