Henry Lee Harrell was born on October 5, 1954, in Kansas City, Missouri, to Delores Harrell and Maurice Harrell.

Henry was educated in the Kansas City, Missouri School District and graduated with honors in May 1974 from Lincoln High School.

He worked at the Hilton Plaza Inn Hotel for 18 years in sanitation and janitorial services, then at Trinity Lutheran Hospital for 8 years, and concluded his career at Research Medical Center, where he dedicated 14 years of service. Henry was a truly hardworking and devoted employee.

Henry had a special artistic talent — he was even-handed and could draw and create true masterpieces. He accepted our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ at an early age and loved the Lord deeply, often sharing His word with everyone he encountered. If you knew Henry, you knew his favorite phrase: “God is in control of all things.” He was a faithful member of Pentecostal Church of God in Christ for many years under the direction of Bishop Daniel M. Jordan and dearly loved his church home.
