Kent enjoyed spending time with his friends and nieces and nephews. He considered Kelli Louise Laurenz his hunka daughter. He was most famous with for his spaghetti and his travel and history stories he would tell them.

He is preceded in death by his parents, grandparents; Frank and Helen


