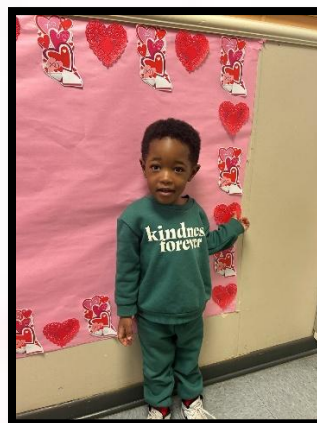
## *Obituary*
