And know I'm still with you.

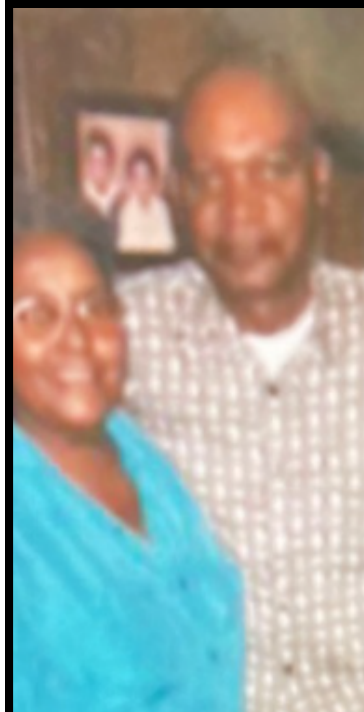
Don't cry because I'm gone,
