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Manning, Othalee E. (Anoatubby), age 92, resident of Shawnee, Oklahoma passed away Tuesday, March 29, 2022, in Shawnee.

Othalee was born March 24, 1930, in Tishomingo, Oklahoma to Joseph and Opal Anoatubby. On Feb. 9, 1948, Othalee married Clarence Manning in Gainesville, TX. They celebrated 55 years of marriage before his passing in 2003.
