Floydrick Lee Washington

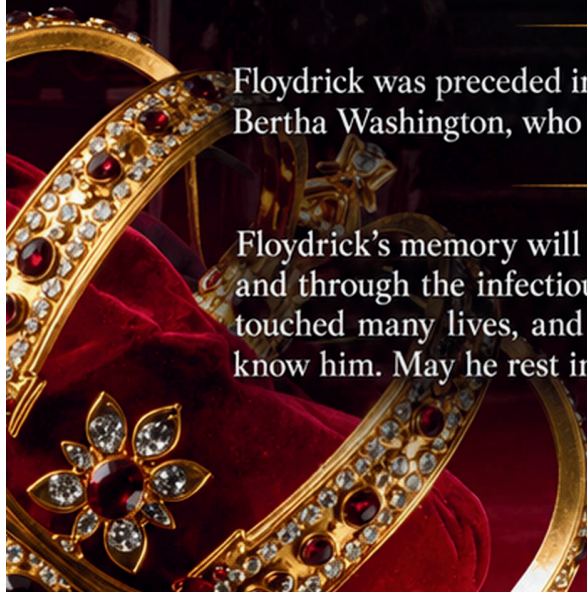
