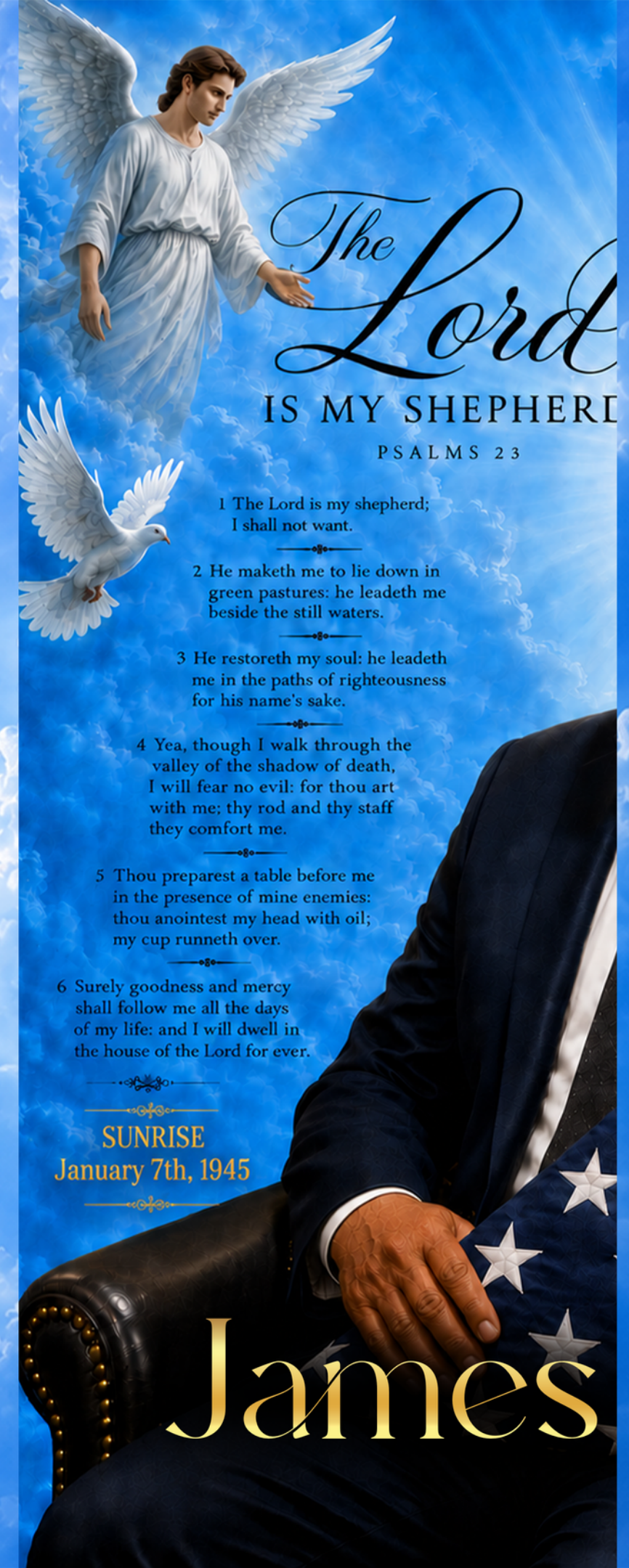

for his name's sake.

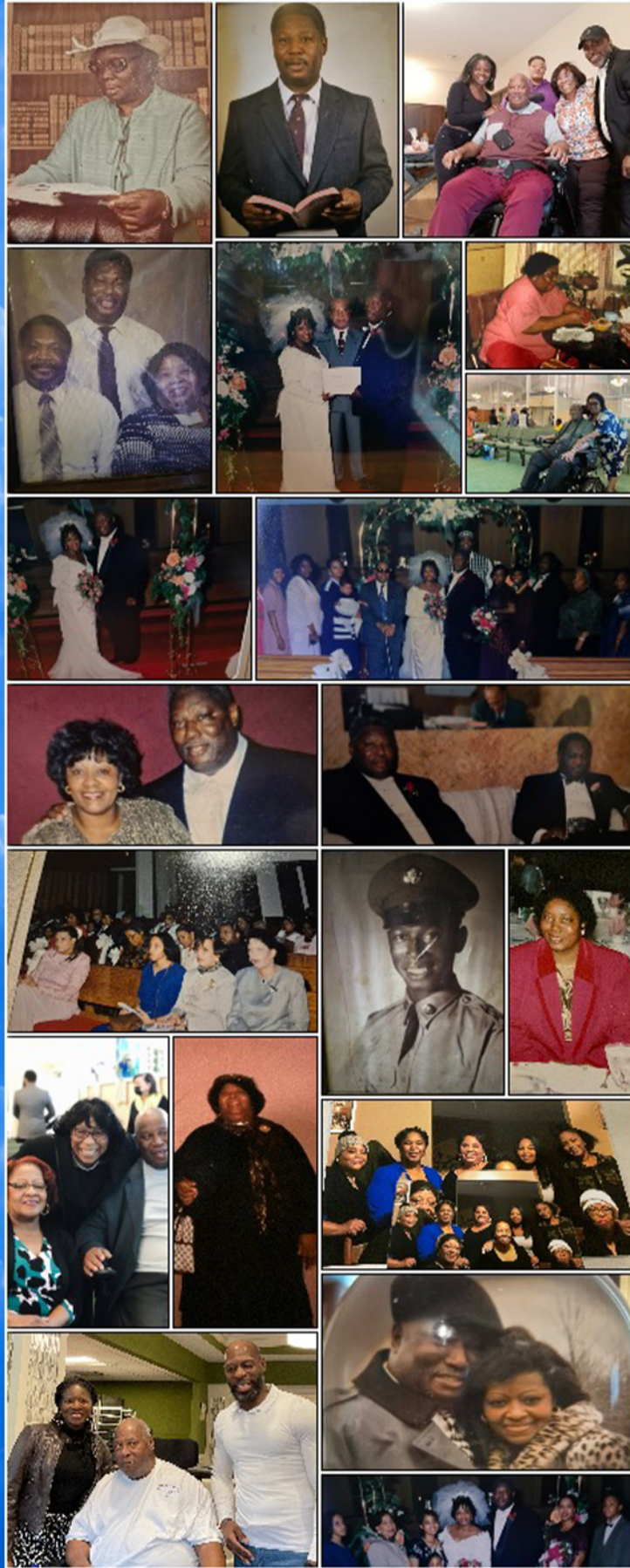
4 Yea, though I walk through the
