And our defense is sure.*

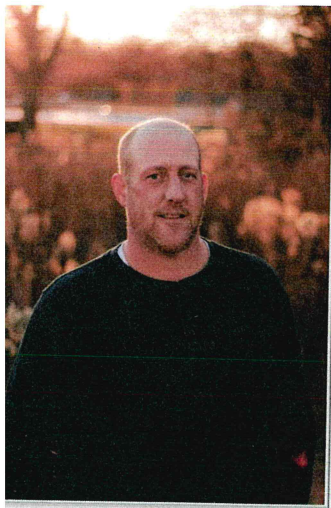
*Before the hills in order stood,
