Ossie was always curious and fearless which resulted in some very interesting predicaments as a child and an adult. We all have so many stories!


He graduated from Denby High School and attended college courses at Wayne County Community College. Not because he enjoyed going to school, but just to prove that he could.

 And he will live forever locked safely within your heart.





